

# Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase

The COUNTY OF UVALDE will hold two public hearings on a proposal to increase total tax revenues from properties on the tax roll in the preceding tax year by .78 percent (percentage by which proposed tax rate exceeds lower of rollback tax rate or effective tax rate calculated under Tax Code Chapter 26). Your individual taxes may increase at a greater or lesser rate, or even decrease, depending on the change in the taxable value of your property in relation to the change in taxable value of all other property and the tax rate that is adopted.

The first public hearing will be held on AUGUST 31, 2017 at 10:00 AM at UVALDE COMMISSIONERS COURTROOM. The second public hearing will be held on SEPTEMBER 11, 2017 at 10:00 AM at UVALDE COMMISSIONERS COURTROOM.

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in 2016 last year was \$ 95,026

Based on last year's tax rate of \$ .7052 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed last year on the average home was \$ 670.12

The average taxable value of a residence homestead in 2017 this year is \$ 100,478

If the governing body adopts the effective tax rate for this year of \$ .6738 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$ 677.02

If the governing body adopts the proposed tax rate of \$ .7409 per \$100 of taxable value, the amount of taxes imposed this year on the average home would be \$ 744.44
