**ORDER PROHIBITING CERTAIN FIREWORKS
IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF UVALDE COUNTY, TEXAS**

WHEREAS On the 9TH day of December, 2024, the Commissioners Court of Uvalde County has determined that conditions on certain uncultivated acreage in the county are extremely hazardous for the danger of fire because of high grass or dry vegetation;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Uvalde County hereby adopts this ORDER prohibiting the sale or use of restricted fireworks in the unincorporated areas of Uvalde County and;

- A. No person may sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks Classified under 49 C.F.R. part. 173.100 (c)(2) (10-1-86 edition), as “skyrockets with sticks” and “missiles with fins” in the unincorporated areas of Uvalde County; and
- B. This ORDER does not prohibit:
 - 1. Common fireworks, small in size as Class C explosives;
 - 2. Large fireworks devices designed primarily to produce visible or audible effects by combustion, deflagration, or detonation and classified as Class B explosive by the U.S, Department of Transportation (TEX.OCC. CODE, Chapter 2154).
- C. A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or intentionally violates a prohibition established by this ORDER. An offense under this ORDER is a Class C Misdemeanor.
