



ORDER SETTING UVALDE COUNTY, TEXAS TAX RATE FOR 2020

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Uvalde County Commissioners Court to set the tax levy in order to provide funds with which to meet the budget requirements of the County and to pay the expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the services provided by the County to Uvalde County residents:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT:

That there is hereby levied and shall be assessed and collected for 2020 an ad valorem tax of \$.7400 per \$100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the county as shown on the final approved 2020 tax rolls.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

That this tax rate is adopted in the following components:

General Fund Maintenance & Operations Tax Rate	.5200
I&S Rate - Debt Service Tax Rate	.0900
Farm to Market-Flood Maintenance & Operations Tax Rate	<u>.1300</u>
2018 Total Ad Valorem Tax Rate	<u>.7400</u>

That the Uvalde County Appraisal District is hereby authorized and directed to prepare 2020 tax statements and transmit same to the owners of taxable property within the County on or before October 1, 2020 or as soon thereafter as possible.
